



## Tejas Eye Hospital Run by Divyajyoti Trust

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News Letter - August 2015



The rising trend has continued. On one hand, we are happy, on the other hand, the new building which is completed only recently, will also start falling short soon. The total staff strength has gone upto 90+. We feel the pressure every minute to manage the show. However, we must praise the efforts of the staff to keep the system up and running with very minor hiccups.

An 8 months old baby was operated for congenital cataract in both eyes – one after the other. Now, Dr. Sheetal is also doing paediatric cataract operations. Dr. Shilpa is screening new born babies for ROP at two places and she has diagnosed 8-10 babies with different stages of ROP. Eight eyes of four babies have been lasered at Mandvi. We are very happy that we are able to help these babies also.

As if Almighty is answering our prayers, one donor – Shri Vijaybhai & Smt. Nipunaben Dalia (Nalinbhai's brother in law) from Surat came forward and declared a donation of 4 acres of land approx. 4 kms away from Mandvi. The declaration was made on 16th August at Bandhu Triputi's ashram in Tithal by Rev. Shri Jin Chandra Vijayji Maharaj. We have started the formalities to get it registered in the name of Divyajyoti trust.

Dr. Dhavat has come back after successfully completing his two months training in medical retina. Now, he will try to help Dr. Shilpa in the retina clinic to the extent possible.

The eye donation fortnight celebration takes place between 25th August to 9th September every year. We organised felicitation of the family members of the eye donors on 28th August jointly with Mandvi Municipal corporation – the CEO and President both presided over the function. “Divyachakshu eye bank” – our eye bank was formally inaugurated alongwith this function. Under tie up with “Lokdrashti eye bank” – Surat, we are getting corneas freely. Since their collection is very high, the supplies of cornea will hopefully not remain a problem anymore. Daily awareness sessions were planned during the fortnight in different villages.

Two schools were screened in Dang district upon suggestion from our well wisher Dr. Amiben Yagnik. Almost 400 children were examined.

Training of new batch of “Vision technician” – a one year programme with six students and “Ophthalmic nursing” – again a one year programme with four students has started this month.

Dr. Vishal Sharma from Jaipur completed his advanced phaco training this month. He was so happy with the over all experience, that he donated Rs. 10000/-.

Dr. Uday did a clinical audit of the operation theatres of Chittaur district under Govt. set up at the suggestion of Sightsavers. The main district hospital in Chiattuar and sub district hospital in Nimbahera were looked at. We get a deep satisfaction in these activities of being able to help many people in remote locations to improve upon their existing set ups and implement better infection control practices.

A CME on diabetes was held by IMA Mandvi in our meeting hall. The CME was attended by nearly 50 delegates – a good number for a small branch like Mandvi. Dr. Amish Patel – our trustee and a retina specialist from Ahmedabad and Dr. Hardik Chandarana delivered the lectures followed by question answer session.

The construction workers are still present in the new building. Hopefully, by the end of the month, we will be able to start using the offices also. The process for IGBC registration is going on and we are trying to take care of the documentation part now.

The filed work for the survey for Umaprada and Mangrol project is completed by the end of the month. Module II training of the workers will start next month. Kudos to the field staff for their sincere efforts.

Blind children of our hostel received one pair of uniform from the “Primary Teacher's Association of Mandvi” during the month.
