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News Letter - January 2014



February was not as busy as January. Still total procedures were in the tune of 700. Retina surgical work has been continued with the help of visiting surgeons just like last month. Dr. Parth Joshi has joined the team and adjusted well in short time. Dr. Dhavat Sukhramwala is joining from middle of March. Dr. Shilpa will join from 1st April completing the team.

We have started providing towel to our patients to ensure they take bath in the morning before surgery. This has added one task to all the activities that we are doing BUT this we felt will add to the quality, we have taken up additional burden.

A mega camp for KAPS was organised in this month. Totally 86 operations were carried out successfully. Shri L. K. Jain site director of KAPS came specially at the time of discharge of patients from the hospital to distribute utensils and Blankets to the patients. He praised the efforts of our team. Shri V. K. Jain – station director also visited the hospital and was happy with the activities.

Dr. Yashvantbhai Patel and Dr. Ashvinbhai Patel of Combat Blindness International visited us in the month and provided major financial support for paediatric operations. They also donated 530 lenses and 170 kits for cataract operations. They assured us of long term collaboration.

10 Diabetic retinopathy screening camps were organised in the month of February across the whole of Mandvi taluka. However, the response from the diabetic patients has remained very low. Somehow, the lack of awareness is the major obstacle and we realise that we will need to put in much more efforts at awareness generation. Even when the workers visited the patients at home to find out why only 109 patients out of 800 reported to the hospital, one prominent common answer was, we don't have a problem, you are unnecessarily putting doubts in our mind. In cities, where the patients are pro active and go to the doctor even for smallest of the problems, here in rural area, when we find out and tell the patient that you are diabetic, they don't want to believe us.

After the evaluation of the OT protocol, we have planned evaluation of our outreach activities in the middle of April.

The no. of patients for our Neuro Ophthalmologist, Dr. Tanuja Rakhe has increased and she gracefully agreed to come twice in a month. She keeps very busy. More satisfying fact is that many patients have improved clinically and have shown pleasure about it. Some case studies are also being prepared.

Dr. Rohan Chariwala and Dr. Sheetal Chaudhary attended the All India Ophthalmological conference held in Agra. Dr. Rohan presented a paper on "Rapid assessment of Avoidable Blindness". Dr. Khushboo – our retina specialist also presented a paper from her work done here in Mandvi. There were two other posters also from the hospital in the conference. Dr. Uday attended protocol committee meeting at Gandhinagar to present the final version of the protocol to the health commissioner. and the final version of the protocol for the state will now be printed soon.

Mr. Bhavesh Rathod visited RNC free eye hospital, Valsad to show them the data entry into the HMIS of NPCB. He also visited Blind School, Surat to screen the students there. Of the 130 students screened, 46 students are called to Mandvi hospital for detailed low vision assessment and to see if corneal transplant can help them.

Mr. Amar – Dr. Rohan Thakkar's staff has come here for training in OT techniques.

We have procured life saving equipments from our local MLA Shri Prabhubhai Vasava's grant. This is a good value addition to our services.

Solar system of 15KVA grid connect system and 3 KVA battery back up system is installed and functional now. We will be able to save good bit of money from electricity bill and we are that much eco friendly now.
