It has rained well in later half of the month – a welcome thing to happen. However, it naturally reduced the patient inflow. We got some time to reflect upon and plan for the future. Dr. Bhavin Patel – eminent retina specialist from Surat visited one more time during the month to help Dr. Shilpa perform difficult retina surgeries. Our trustee and treasurer Mrs. Madhavi underwent blepharoplasty during the month – an indicator of quality of work done here.

Mr. Yatin Mistry – our Ophthalmic Assistant now turned in to Eye Bank Technician performed independent enucleation at KAPS township. We are proud of his achievement. There are very few Ophthalmic Assistants who are doing this independently and we have two persons who can do it. The second one is Mr. Pradeep Patel who started doing it before Yatin.

Our poster related to “RAVI” survey done by us with the financial assistance of Sir Dorabjee Tata Trust is accepted at American Academy of Ophthalmology annual conference to be held in Chicago in Oct. 2014. Dr. Rohan Chariwala our research consultant will attend the conference. All the legwork related to his visit is completed including visa procurement. He will under go short term fellowship at John Hopkins, Baltimore, Wisconsin University, Medison and New York Eye and Ear Infirmary, New York. Over and above, he will spend a couple of days with Dr. Kenneth Cohen in New York to understand the prevailing practices in USA. We are proud of this achievement.

Flow of phaco students has continued – now the training is booked till March. Two more SICS students are also booked. Students are praising our training programme.

Nursing training and ophthalmic assistant training is also going on well.

Trustee meeting combined with executive committee meeting took place on 20th July. Trustees were given a presentation of the performance of three years. Everybody applauded the work done in three years.

Mr. Nikhil Mehta (administrator) and Mr. Yatin Mistry (Ophthalmic Assistant) attended the annual meeting of Federation of NGOs of Gujarat in Dahod.

Dr. Uday attended the 10th annual general body meeting with a conference of Vision 2020: The Right to Sight India programme held at Little Flower Eye Hospital, Angamaly, Kerala as a resource person. The School Eye Screening Manual developed by Divyajyoti Trust (Major work done by Dr. Rohan Chariwala) was released on this occasion. A proud moment for us.

Mrs. Seema Parikh from Torrent Power, Surat delivered a lecture on Japanese system of 5S reliance to the senior staff members. It is all about increasing the efficiency and accuracy of work – how Japan has made major strides as compared to the rest of the world. Staff enjoyed the talk and hopefully they will put it into practice.

Mrs. Seena Bookselar – a dietician from Surat, talked about diet and nutrition with the nursing staff. They understood the nutritional value of food items for the first time and the misunderstanding about food items considered inferior were removed.
