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### News Letter - June 2015

The inauguration function of our training centre building – Netrajyoti talim Kendra took place on 7th June. Rev. Swamiji Sarvasthanandaji from Ramkrishna Ashram, Rajkot presided over the function and inaugurated the building. His advise to keep the patient in the centre of all our activities touched everybody. Donors and wellwishers attended the function in big numbers BUT it was really very hot. We felicitated all our donors for the construction during the function. Final finishing jobs are still going on and we hope to occupy the building from next month. A pooja was organised on 28th of the month just before we occupy the building for residence of staff.

The inspection of the building for certificate of green building took place on 10th June. IGBC is convinced that we are entitled for a “Gold certificate” BUT we are going to try for “Platinum certificate”. Few things will be required to be done for that and we have started working in that direction.

The rising trend has continued in June. We did our first C3R procedure in this month. One more DSEK was performed. In the absence of Dr. Shilpa, who had gone for one month fellowship in ROP screening, Dr. Bhavin and Dr. Khushboo from Surat helped us take care of the surgical work and Dr. Heli and Dr. Saket helped us in continuing the medical retina work in the month.

Dr. Shlipa – our retina specialist and Dr. Sheetal – our glaucoma consultant were away for one month training to Coimbatore and Pune respectively.

Dr. Chintan Maheshwari from Morbi completed his one month fellowship in phacoemulsification and Dr. Akash Shah from Vadodara is here for his two months fellowship in SICS – he will complete his training at the end of next month.

Shri Kakaji from Shri Bhairav Cheritable trust, Bhivandi was here for two weeks exposure in A scan biometry and blocks. He was very happy to understand the details biometry over one week. And give considerable number of blocks. Was happy at the end of the training.

A half day CME for operation theatre staff was organised on 25th June as the work load was quite on the lower side due to rains.

Vipul Joshi and Chintan Shiroya – both from our optical shop went to “The Sukharamwala Optical”, Surat during the month for one week exposure in qualitative improvement of our optical preparation and understand sales technique. They have understood the quality aspect and are happy. We need to purchase a few equipments which we will purchase in near future. We are thankful to the Sukharamwala optical house for providing our workers this opportunity.

The Umaprada and Mangrol project is going on well. The field workers are putting in hard work to move forward. Daily close to 100 fundus photographs are being taken ad are graded the next day by the Ophthalmologist at the base hospital. By now, more than 50% of the survey work is over. However, the fundus photography will take much longer.

The schools have opened again and our blind children are back in the hostel. We are trying to increase the number to 25 this time. Two teenage girls have been sent to Ahmedabad in Andh Kanya Prakash Gruh. They have also settled well. We are happy to be involved in this work. Seeing these children at the end of the day gives a deep sense of satisfaction.
