News Letter - June 2013



Inspite of an early full blown monsoon, the workload has not gone down too much. More than 100 OPD patients is becoming a regular activity. Based on the vision building workshop conducted in May, we have decided to create two units and make sure that two Ophthalmologists will see OPD simultaneously. We will take care of refraction in four rooms at a time. This will ensure a rapid turnover of the patients.

We are gearing up for the possible workload during winter and as a part of the same, we are discussing creation of a septic OT away from the main OT also so that we can provide OT to our retina specialist in the morning without compromising cataract surgical work.

Empanelment with KAPS was executed from this month. We have also started seeing weekly OPD on every Wednesday at their clinic in the township. 4-5 surgeries have already taken place and patients have expressed satisfaction about the services.

Neuro Ophthalmologist Dr. Tanuja Rakhe has started coming regularly once in a month and she is seeing good no. of patients.

Dr. Nikhil Rishikeshi from Pune – paediatric ophthalmologist came once more and performed 10 paediatric surgeries.

Dr. Uday, Dr. Rohan and Dr. Parimal conducted evaluation exercise of Netrajyoti Eye Hospital run by Badmer Jan Seva Samitee, badmer. Dr. Rohan evaluated their vision centre activities.

Dr. Uday and Madhaviben visited Chorwad hospital early in the month. A good establishment with huge investment is lying idle and after seeing that, a consensus has been developed that we should indirectly try to help them. The details will be worked out now.

Hostel for the blind students was started from this month. There are 15 blind children in the hostel. One of our CBR worker has been appointed as rector for the hostel and she is really taking very good care of the kids. Incidentally, the kids have settled so well in the hostel that we feel as if they are in the hostel for many years. All the kids are going to school in nearby Govt. school and teachers are also co operating well. They have received school kits, school bag, uniform, daily chores items, chappals, raincoat etc. as donation from people of Mandvi town. We thank each and every body who has helped us even in a small way for this work.

An educational tour for our staff was conducted in two groups. Teams visited Anjali, Ranasan – Sahyog Kushthrog Trust, Rajendranagar – Sarvajanic hospital, Modasa – CHC, Shamlaji. All the members were touched by the humanitarian work being done at Sahyog Kushthrog Trust. They liked the discipline followed at Ranasan and professionalism of CHC, Shamlaji. Their suggestions based on this visit are being implemented gradually. We look forward to improving our system based on their feedback.

Children of our staff were sent to Surat for a half a day picnic. They enjoyed various rides and visited temple also.

Mr. Nikhil Mehta our administrator attended the annual general meeting of primary teacher's asso. of Mandvi on 23.06.2013. He appreciated the support of the teachers in our work. The teachers promised us to continue their support.

Biogas plant was commissioned this month and we have started using the same. A small step in the direction of becoming eco friendly. We have started using solar cookers also for cooking. All thanks to Shri Ameetsingh Waghela – our consultant.

A workshop for OT staff was conducted under the aegis of Vision 2020: Right to Sight in Ahmedabad with the help of cornea foundation. More than 200 participants attended the same. This was beyond our own expectations. Many people were standing and a suggestion has come to hold one more workshop of this kind for the Ophthalmologists.
