News Letter - March 2015

The year has ended with a pleasant note. The workload has increased by nearly 20% without any additional efforts from our side. We are telling the staff to strengthen the systems and remain patient friendly & focus on the quality of care only. This we understand will eventually lead to progress.

Dr. Dhavatbhai and two staff nurses Rekha and Lata attended the Bihar camp organised by Bhansali trust. They had a rich learning experience. We send doctor and nurses to this camp as a gesture of support to this humanitarian task undertaken by Bhansalit trust. Our salutes to them for this mammoth work being done where there are very little services available and that too year after year.

Dr. Shilpa attended the retina conference at Chandigadh between 13 to 16 March.

Dr. Uday attended the eye bank committee meeting organised by Govt. of Gujarat on 5th March in Gandhinagar. He also attended the District planning workshop for the Govt. of Orissa organised by Sightsavers as a resource person on 10th March at Bhuvaneshwar. Dr. Uday attended the annual conference of International Federation of Infection Control and Hospital Infection Society of India between 22nd to 24th March. He was the only Ophthalmologist attending this infection control conference.

Dr. Parth Gandhi from Surendranagar has completed his phacoemulsification training this month. Dr. Upasana Patel from Bharuch has joined us as a part of her one year placement in CHC having completed her D.O. from Visnagar.

We had organised a workshop on counselling on behalf of Vision 2020 : Right to Sight Gujarat chapter on 15th March at Polio foundation, Ahmedabad. Eminent speakers from Gujarat spared their time to deliver their talks in Gujarati. More than 100 participants were there from across Gujarat. This kind of a workshop exclusively on counselling was taking place for the first time in Gujarat. We sincerely appreciate the support from Polio foundation for allowing us to use their infra structure free of cost.

The new building now looks pretty. Now, we are pushing the accelerator to complete the building in all respect before the stipulated date of inauguration on 7th June. Plumbing, electrification and colour – all jobs are going on in full swing. At this point of time, there are more than 100 workers working in the building.

Shri Bharatsinh Parmar – M. P. from Bharuch area visited the hospital during the month. Mr. Danny Chundoo and Joel – his wife – members of Rotary club of Scotland also visited us during the month.

Door to door survey for the Umarpada and Mangrol blocks has started. 25 workers are involved in conducting the survey. Blood sugar, blood pressure and intra ocular pressure measurement has also started for which, we had received the XOVA award. We have added fundus photography also in the same to capture glaucoma and diabetic retinopathy better. The whole system is vibrating with activities. Workers are also excited and we are also excited about the fact that we are doing something which is not done anywhere in the country.

Our hostel children will complete second year in the hostel. They have come up a long way. Even in music, they have made good progress. They are now able to sing different “ragas” on the tune of harmonium. Their academic progress is also satisfactory.
