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News Letter - May 2014



It was very hot during the month and the flow of patients remained low. Temperatures were crossing 40s almost daily. Still the surgical work has continued well because of the extra camps conducted in the Mandvi area. We celebrated our 3rd annual day on 22nd May with a cultural programme by the staff and children in the hostel, followed by dinner with the staff and family. Before that, we held Ganeshpujan in the newly constructed septic OT.

We had invited Ms. Priya – manager from Aravind Eye Hospital, Pondicherry for one week to look at our administrative activities and suggest improvements. She looked at all the areas very carefully and has pointed out many small suggestions which will help us improve our administrative systems. The report is with us, now we have to discuss and act upon the suggestions made by her.

Dr. Uday had gone to two eye hospitals for evaluation at the suggestion of Sightsavers. He visited Sitapur Eye Hospital, Sitapur and Mohammadi unit of Shroff's Charity Eye Hospital, Shahjahanpur both in UP. This kind of consultancy visits gives us an opportunity to see how others are working in remote areas and what difficulties are faced by them.

Dr. Uday was invited to Vivekananda Mission Ashram, West Bengal by Vision 2020: Right to Sight India programme to speak on OP and IP protocols to be followed in the hospital at the Quality assurance workshop organised there.

We hosted a glaucoma CME under the aegis of Vision 2020: Right to Sight India programme in Surat. Eminent faculties like Dr. Devindra Sood from Eye Q Delhi and Dr. Mayuriben Khamar from Ahmedabad delivered a feast of scientific facts about glaucoma. About 50 participants were there who enjoyed this. It was a good learning experience for us. Dr. Sood came down to Mandvi also on Friday and examined patients which was a good learning for our glaucoma consultant Dr. Sheetal and beneficial to our patients also.

The Govt. of Gujarat has circulated the final infection control protocol in this month to all the stakeholders. Our superintendent Dr. Uday was a member of the team who formulated this protocol.

Towards the end of April, Dr. Chintan Dholakia – our Ophthalmologist has gone to Narayana Netralaya, Bangalore for three months short term fellowship in Glaucoma.

We make use of this time of the year for training and CMEs and other activities to strengthen the team. As a part of it, all the staff members were taken to two near by hospitals in two batches as a part of the educational tour. They visited Gram Sewa Trust, Kharel and RNC Free eye hospital, Valsad. This kind of visits gives them an opportunity to compare the systems at other places and come back with suggestions for improvement in our system. After the visit to the hospitals, they went to the sea shore in Tithal near Valsad.

Similarly, we invited Shri Falgunbhai Sheth from Shaishav, Bhavnagar to conduct a communication workshop. Select 25 staff members were involved in this workshop. Over two days, he made them understand the importance and methods of communication via games in a very lucid manner. The staff really enjoyed it and said that this time it was actually fun learning communication skills.

We conducted a week long workshop for the blind children just like doing it every year. The difference this time was that they were taken to visit Sayla and they climbed Chotila. This was their suggestion for more than a year and we had promised them to arrange the same this time. They were very happy. 22 children joined the group. The parents were informed about the potential lying in these children and were encouraged to make sure that the children continue their academic pursuit in spite of small obstructions.
