



## Tejas Eye Hospital Run by Divyajyoti Trust

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The work has continued unabated. Although the heat of summer did cause some reduction in the work, we were busy with lot of other activities.

The first annual function of the Divyajyoti Trust took place on 20th May. Attended by more than 600 people. This has encouraged us tremendously. The support from the community is over whelming and we will do our best to live upto the mark. The Rotary Club of Surat Roundtown, handed over the corneal transplant related equipments to us during the function. KAPS people declared their commitment to give us the retina surgery equipments. We inaugurated the Community Based Rehabilitation Programme for the blinds for Mandvi taluka. Prof. Shri Ramnikbhai Halari, hon. Secretary of NAB, Visnagar branch and Shri Biharibhai Shah hon. Secretary NAB, Mumbai were our honourable guests for the function – they encouraged blinds to become independent and come out of the mindset of being useless to become useful and contributing members of the society.

The module I training of CBR workers was completed by the first week of the month and the survey for blindness has been started. We have included screening of the community > 40 years of age for diabetes by RBS and urine sugar. This will be a unique activity where almost 30000 people will be screened door to door for diabetes in one block. We have also included a survey of social status of the community along with this survey. Diagnostic eye camps with the survey have been started and the response is very good – each camp is yielding more than 15 patients with an OPD in the tune of 150. Daily there are patients walking into the hospital with refer slips from the survey.

We have received the clearance from KAPS regarding funding for the retina surgical instruments and now we are in the process of taking demo of different machines to finalise which one to buy. We have already taken demo of three machines and two more are lined up.

All the staff members have visited Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai in two batches this month. They have come back with lot of suggestions. Now, we will consider implementing some of the suggestions in due course of time. The teams visited Kanyakumari and Rameshwaram after the visit to the Aravind. They had the unique opportunity to see sunrise at Kanyakumari where one sees ocean on three sides and land only on one side and the sun rises from the sea. All the team members are very happy.

We did six more corneal transplants in May. Now, that we have the eye bank specular microscope also available, we will be able to evaluate the donor corneas better.

We have applied for the membership of Vision 2020: Right to Sight India Programme.

Process to get ISO certification is initiated. Hope to get the clearance in 2-3 months time.

For the first time, we operated upon a six months old baby for cataract.

Dr. Parimal Chariwala has joined us as a full time medical officer from 10th May 2012.
