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News Letter - May 2013



April & May were really very hot. The workload has come down to some extent. However, the work in retina and cornea has continued unabated.

We have crossed 100 mark in corneal transplants. By now, the figure has reached 107. We celebrated the same on 19th May with our executive committee members and with local leaders from Mandvi town.

A diabetic retinopathy screening camp was organised on 27th April at Niramaya clinic in Kevadiya colony. More than 90 patients were screened.

On 22nd May – our second annual day, a cultural programme was organised – all the staff members took part enthusiastically. This was followed by dinner with the staff and family members. Prizes to the winners of the games were also distributed along with this and all the staff members who performed in the programme were given a token prize for encouraging them to participate more actively.

Our team participated in the annual general meeting of Vision 2020: Right to Sight India programme on 6-7 April. This was the first opportunity for most of the team members to get exposed to the outside world of eye care. They enjoyed the gathering and learnt more about eye care.

Dr. Rohan and Dr. Khushboo participated in the DOS annual conference. Both presented posters there and Dr. Rohan in addition was a faculty also.

Dr. Uday conducted clinical evaluation of Mahatma Gandhi Eye Hospital in Lucknow in April on request from Sightsavers. Two more hospitals – one in Chorwad and one in Wankaner were evaluated in May.

A strategic planning workshop for our team was organised with the help of Dr. G. V. Rao and Dr. Col. Deshpande from Vision 2020: Right to Sight India programme on 4-5 May. Our team participated enthusiastically and good discussion took place. Final strategic plan will now be worked out in consultation with Vision 2020: Right to Sight India programme. This will help us prepare a road map from next 5 years. The team building will take place as a fall out of the workshop which will be good for us in the future.

A grant for Eye donation centre under NPCB was released for our centre and necessary equipments etc. will be procured soon.

Two Ophthalmologists Dr. Divya and Dr. Chirag have joined their phaco training from May onwards. Two students from Jivan Akshay Charitable Trust, Vadodara have joined their training as outreach paramedic from April 2013.

Past president of Lions International Shri Ashokbhai Mehta and Shri Bharatbhai Pathak visited us in April to discuss revival of their hospital in Chorwad. Dr. Dineshbhai Khandhadia and Dr. V. C. Poria – both microbiologists visited us twice to strengthen our laboratory work up in corneal ulcer cases with a particular emphasis on fungal ulcers as we are getting many fungal corneal ulcers.

Field work for the “Rapid assessment of Visual Impairment” study has been completed in April and May. The whole team including Dr. Rohan have taken lot of trouble to finish the field work as planned. Now data entry and data analysis will be done in near future. This study has been supported by Sir Dorabjee Tata Trust.

ONGC has released a grant of Rs. 3.9 lacs towards 400 cataract operations under their CSR project. Diagnostic eye camps have been conducted from this fund in April and May. Some more camps will be conducted in June to complete 400 cataract operations.

A get to gather of ASHA workers was organised on 10th May. More than 100 ASHA workers attended the same. Information about possible incentive on bringing cataract patients for operations at Govt. facility in the tune of Rs. 175/- was given to them. They have promised to send cataract patients for operations to nearest Govt. facility.

Fire safety training of our staff was organised on 9th April with the help of fire department of Kakrapar Atomic Power Station – this was done during the fire safety fortnight being celebrated every year.

We have started showing films to staff and family now on every 2nd and 4th Friday of the month.

Biogas plant has been installed behind our kitchen and we have started using biogas for cooking purpose. We have also started using solar cooker for cooking and thus we are trying to save fuel and use natural energy available.

A workshop on “Dissemination of action plan for diabetic retinopathy in Gujarat” was organised under the aegis of Vision 2020: Right to Sight Gujarat chapter in Anand on 28th April.

Anand & Nadiad ophthalmic society, AGOS and NPCB joined hands for this workshop. Total attendance was close to 50. The deliberations of the workshop will be useful for future implementation of the DR action plan. This workshop was sponsored by Cipla.

Another workshop was organised in Dahod at Drashti Netralaya for “Strengthening Refractive Error services” on 26th May. Total 110 delegates including 55 from outside Dahod attended the same. What they appreciated the most was the fact that all the speakers were from their fraternity only. They demanded another similar workshop.
