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News Letter - October 2014



We wish all our friends, well wishers and donors a very Happy and Prosperous New Year.

Due to Diwali festival, the workload had gone down to some extent this month. BUT we did four surgeries on Saturday – Bhaiduj – suggestive of the fact that now, people don't think so much about festivals. They do come for surgery even during festival.

However, we were pained to see a series of patients coming very late to us. We could not help four such patients and they ended up losing vision in one eye. All these were cornea patients. The story remains the same for retina and glaucoma also. Now, we are planning to start so called tracking the patients. Once our new counsellor is trained, we shall post one separate counsellor in clinic area and that person will track the patients and if they don't come for follow up on the given date, will call them – write letters etc

An unusual oculoplasty operation for a case of neurofibromatosis on a young boy was performed by Dr. Saurin Gandhi during the month. It gives us immense pleasure when we are able to help such needy young patients.

Dr. Sheetal Chaudhari, Dr. Parth Joshi, Dr. Chintan Dholakia, Dr. Shilpa Patel attended the All Gujarat Ophthalmic conference in Ahmedabad during the month and presented a video of worm removal, posters on glaucoma, visual impairment survey etc.

Mr. Alpesh Mistry, our Ophthalmic Assistant went to Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai for ocularist training this month. He has come back upon successful completion of the training. He prepared two artificial eyes during training. Now, we will set up ocular prosthesis centre with the help of Mehta Charitable trust.

As a part of World Sight Day celebration, our team of paramedics performed street plays in three villages during evening hours followed by door to door screening of the community in the same villages next morning. This was done keeping in mind the low awareness levels in the area.

Dr. Mansi and Dr. Geetika completed their training in SICS during this month. Dr. Saurabh Patel will soon complete his phaco training.

LCIF office bearers - Ms. Aruna Oswal from Oswal group of Industries - vice chair person of steering committee of LCIF, Ms. Linda Derr - Regional programme specialist, South Asia - LCIF, Mrs. Zenobia Keikobad - LCIF grants financial coordinator, Mumbai and Dr. Jateenbhai Shah – LCIF technical advisor, Western region alongwith district Governor Mr. Khedkar, PDG Lion Mr. Ashokbhai Kanungo, Shri Jamshedbhai dotiwala and Shri Aravindbhai Patel etc. visited us in relation to our proposal submitted to LCIF for our Diabetic Retinopathy project. They were very happy and proposed to the body that this project should be sanctioned.

Mr. Jha, CSR head of NPCIL from Mumbai office also visited us and expressed pleasure on seeing the humanitarian work. To our surprise, the total value of the free retina surgical work done till date comes to Rs. 1.5 crore at market value. We were also amazed to see the figure.

Our local M.P. – Mr. Prabhubhai Vasava also visited us during the month and was happy to see the work. He has been supportive of our work right from the beginning.

A meeting with Shri Vijaybhai Dalal whose Rotary club of North Bergen, New Jersey was our partner in the matching grant project and also an active member of Share and Care Foundation USA previously, was organised at Shri Kulbandhu Sharma's place early this month. Another matching grant project was discussed in the meeting.

We examined 47 blind students from Blind School, Surat for low vision. 22 of them were provided spectacles, two were given low vision devices and six have been advised surgeries.

Our research consultant Dr. Rohan Chariwala presented scientific poster on RAVI survey at American Academy of Ophthalmology, held at Chicago, USA between 18-21st October 2014. In addition he visited various premier eye institutes to do short observerships at New York Eye and Ear Infirmary (New York), John Hopkins Eye Institute-Wilmer eye (Baltimore), University of Wisconsin (Madison) and Emory University (Atlanta) to understand the practices prevailing in USA. Visit was academically very useful and informative to improve eye care services at our hospital. He was accompanied by his wife.

Ganeshbhai Dodia, our braille teacher went to the BRC bhavan, Mandvi during teacher's training as a resource person in VI. Dr. Uday Gajiwala went to Kolkatta to speak on infection control and quality of cataract services at the Lions conclave for district 323.

Rotary club of Surat Main felicitated Dr. Uday Gajiwala during the month for his humanitarian work of more than 23 years. They published small awareness article on eye care in their newsletter written by Dr. Uday Gajiwala.

A get to gather of ASHA workers of mandvi block was organised by us. We have decided to give them incentive of Rs. 175/- per patient if they bring the patient for cataract surgery to our hospital – although, the Govt, will not provide this support to us.

Our blind children have now started making paper bags which we use in our medical store to supply medicines – we have stopped using plastic bags. They prepared candle lamps also which were sold from the hostel. Thus, they are learning some vocational activities also.

This year also, the children have won prizes worth Rs. 42,000/- at Khel Mahakumbh held by Govt. of Gujarat just like last year. Two of them who have won first prize, will now represent at state level in Dahod.

35 AC clearance for our trust has occurred during the month, we are now waiting for the certificate to reach us. Then we will start talking about it to the donors.

A get to gather of staff with family members was held on 24th – Diwali.

Shri Vasantbhai Gajera of Laxmi Diamonds, Surat and his team visited us early this month and distributed food grains to almost 1000 poor families in the area. They were impressed by the humanitarian eye care work going on here.

Pran pratishtha mahotsav in the newly constructed temples in Peterkui and Pipalvan villages was organised during the month.
