News Letter - October 2015



Our trustee – a life time Gnadhian Shri Bhikhubhai Vyas and Smt. Kokilaben Vyas have worked for their whole life in the upliftment of the rural poor community. Their work in the interior remote area of Dharampur taluka of years has been acknowledged under “Incredible innovation” on “Times now” channel. We have gained lot of inspiration from seniors and elders like them only.

Dr. Chintan Mehta – a paediatric ophthalmologist has joined us full time from 1st October. We welcome him in the family. His presence will enable us to treat all the paediatric cases without any delay.

A squint detection and treatment camp was organised on 16th Oct. Four squint operations including two paediatric patients were operated.

Our team has completed the RAAB survey data collection ahead of time. The team worked hard and both the teams completed two clusters daily. They had an in-depth exposure to the realities of the poor tribal area of Jhabua district and they realised the hardships the people face living in that area. The community still leaves under very old orthodox concepts and are not willing to accept the surgical services offered to them. A huge lack of awareness was observed and our gut feeling is that the overall blindness also will be more than the national average.

Dr. Sheetal left for USA. She will be doing two short term observerships – one at Wisconsin university under Dr. Chandra and the other at Keyser group in California with Dr. Chen. We are thankful to Dr. Jyotsom Ganatra who was instrumental in organising one at California. Later she will attend American Academy meeting and then come back by 20th Nov.

Dr. Rohan Chariwala has presented two papers and two posters at the All Gujarat Ophthalmic Conference held in Anand during the month. Our academic activities are getting stronger and stronger.

Dr. Sheetal Chaudhary also presented a poster at the Glaucoma Society of India conference in Mumbai during the month.

With Dr. Akash Shah joining us specifically to strengthen the data collection for various clinical studies, we look forward to a further improved performance in coming year or two.

Dr. Darshan Kalaigar attended a CME on eye banking organised by Ee bank association of India in Delhi.

Dr. Uday attended the Association of Community Ophthalmologists of India (ACOIN) meeting in lucknow and presented an oration on “Our experiences in Community Ophthalmology in Rural area”. He was awarded Dr. Arup and Dr. Mrs. Meenakshi Midya memorial ACOIN award 2014 for his outstanding work in the field of community ophthalmology over the years.

Dr. Uday was felicitated for his humane activities by the “Rotary Club of Surat – Roundtown” during the month.

Dr. Uday did evaluation of two hospitals in North East at the suggestion of Mission for Vision, Mumbai. The Ramkrishna Mission hospital, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh and Bansara Eye Care centre in Shilong, Meghalaya – it was an eye opener for him to see the wonderful work being done at these remote locations. The population is so scattered that it is difficult for the organisation to reach out to the community and in turn for the community to reach the hospital. Hats off to the hard work being done by these philanthropic people in these difficult terrains.

Dr. Fatema Hathiyari from Savarkundla and Dr. Vibhor Gupta from Delhi completed their phaco training this month. Dr. Hetvi Desai has joined SICS fellowship of two months duration from this month. Dr. Kumarpal Jhala has continued his SICS training in this second month and at the same time, has joined medical retina fellowship also.

Team of OT staff from Sewa Sadan eye hospital, Bhopal were here for one week training during this month.

A CME on “Respiratory disorders” was organised by IMA Mandvi in our meeting hall. The CME was attended by nearly 27 delegates . This activity was supported by CIPLA.

The construction workers are now leaving the new building one by one and we will be able to occupy the building completely around Diwali. In the mean time, we have submitted final documents for registration with IGBC during the month and look forward to getting the certificate soon.

The field workers for Umaprada and Mangrol project have started actual implementation of the project – the rehabilitation work has started now. The fundus photography work will continue for quite some time.

Blind children of our hostel inaugurated new “gym” in Mandvi. Shri Narendrabhai our volunteer from Mumbai takes care of teaching various exercises to the children. Kids are also enjoying the session of exercise and look forward to the same daily. One sad news is that one of our hostel inmates – Kaushik was taken home by his parents and there he developed diarrhoea and vomiting and we lost him. We pray to Almighty for the departed little soul.
