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News Letter - September 2015



It has rained very little this year. The workload has remained high through out the rainy season this year BUT it is going to be tough for the common man as the prices will skyrocket and the earnings will remain the same or go down.

One four years old child with retinoblastoma in one eye underwent exenteration during this month and is sent to Lions cancer institute in Surat civil hospital for radiation. Fortunately, the second eye is normal. They were coming from Surat and belonged to poor class. This would not have been possible in Surat. We are happy that we could help the child.

Two good news came during the month. Our proposal for glaucoma clinic has been approved by KAPS authority under their CSR activities. Now, it is a question of completing the necessary formalities – we will get these equipments which will eventually be useful in treating the poor patients of our area. Similarly, LCIF has approved our Diabetic retinopathy project partially and now once we fulfil their formalities, the high end microscope dedicated for retina surgical work will become available.

Our team had gone to Lucknow for training in conducting RAAB survey for Sightsavers in Jhabua district of Madhya Pradesh. Dr. B. R. Shamanna our long time friend was the trainer. Immediately, upon completion of the training, the team has proceeded to Jhabua and the field was started on 21st September. Against all odds, the team is putting in such hard work and long hours that they are completing two clusters each day. We should be able to complete the data collection way ahead of expected dates.

Inauguration of the newly constructed operation theatre in Netrang CHC by the Govt. took place on 11th Sept. at the hands of our chief minister Smt. Anandiben Patel. It looks very good. Now, we will start the surgical work soon. The surgical work remained suspended for more than one year.

Training of new batch of “Vision technician” and “Ophthalmic nursing” – is progressing satisfactorily.

Dr. Rohan attended one day training of trainers for training of PG students at Bangalore. Dr. Rohan and Mr. Yatin Mistry attended one week training in eye banking at Hyderabad Eye Institute.

Dr. Vikas Patel from Navsari and Dr. Pratik Gheewala from Surat completed their phaco training this month. Dr. Kumarpal Jhala from Surendranagar has joined SICS fellowship of two months duration from this month.

Team of OT staff and Ophthalmic assistants from Jhabua and satna were here for one week training during this month.

A session on Rose K lenses was organised with the help of Mr. Nirav Mehta – principal of optometry school in Rotary eye institute, Navsari during the month. For the first time, one of our patients will get a rose K lens. We are happy that we have moved one step forward in training of our cornea fellow.

A diabetic retinopathy screening camp was organised at base hospital towards the end of the month. 32 patients came for examination and three got lasered. The awareness is missing badly in our area. We have decided to conduct one speciality camp every month at the base hospital.

A CME on “Managing retinal issues in general Ophthalmology practice” was organised with the help of CIPLA. Dr. Bharat Ramchandani – very enthusiastic and true academician from Waduwalla Eye Institute, Vadodara was our guest speaker. As usual , we had invited our colleagues from Rotary Eye Institute- Navsari, RNC hospital, Valsad and from SEWA Rural, Jhagadia. All those who were present, enjoyed the academic feast presented by Dr. Ramchandani.

Mr. Ravi Pattansetti was invited to visit our hospital for two days to look at our infection control practices and give suggestions. He was requested to conduct a CME also for the paramedical staff. All the paramedics enjoyed the CME and learnt a lot. They demanded to call Ravi more frequently. Ravi has observed our infection control practices and will now give his suggestions.

A CME on “hand hygiene” was organised by IMA Mandvi in our meeting hall. The CME was attended by nearly 57 delegates including doctors and paramedical staff – a good number for a small branch like Mandvi.

Mr. Ravi Pattansetti – infection control co ordinator from Apollo hospital, Ahmedabad was the resource person. He presented the importance of frequent hand washing in a very simple and lucid manner with so many examples.

The construction workers are still present in the new building. We are fed up and frustrated – even after four months of inauguration, we are not able to use the building fully.

The field workers for Umaprada and Mangrol project have undergone module II training during this month. As a part of the training they were sent to Blind People’s Association, Ahmedabad for one week. The rehabilitation work will start now. However, the fundus photography etc. will continue alongside.

The community in Mandvi town enthusiastically keeps inviting our blind children on any and all occasions and during festival season in particular. They enjoyed feast frequently during the month. Majority of the students are making good progress academically barring one or two.
