NETRAJYOTI TRAINING CENTRE

- Training of optometry students is going on well.

- Practical exam of nursing staff was taken by Mrs. Anilaben from Ankleshwar during this month. She took one session on interpretation of pulse examination with the staff. She took one session on basics of nursing with the vision assistant students.
- One session on counselling was taken by Alcon team for our counselling team and OA staff. There will be two more sessions at a later date. All the outreach staff also joined online for the session

VISION CENTRES

- We have continued bimonthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres. During this month, our team has visited Kosamba, Khapar, Bardoli and Ankleshwar centres.

TRUCK DRIVERS' EYE CHECK UP:

- GUJARAT Chemical Port Limited team came forward with a request to screen 4000 truck drivers this year. We have continued beyond 4000 as per their request. This month, we have screened 271 Truck drivers and distributed 137 ready reading glasses and 7 Tailor-made glasses.
- We have started school screening activity from last month. We have screened 1877 school children in 20 schools of Netrang taluka. 24 students were provided with glasses and 20 Students have been referred to the base hospital for detailed examination.

Research Project

- We have started enrolment of patients in Eyecryl Toric IOL study, Eyecryl 600 plus IOL study and Eyecryl ASHFY 600 IOL study of Biotech last month. 13 patients have been enrolled during the month. Enrolment of patients has been started for Omni EDOF IOL study also during the month.
- Follow up of all 40 patients in Occlutab study is completed now. The data has been sent to Dr. Prof. Handa, Japan.
- Dr. Rohan Khemlani from OUC, Japan conducted field work to collect data using the smart phone based slit lamp developed by the company.

CONSULTANCY AND EVALUATION:

- Dr. Uday conducted clinical audits of Jamshedpur Eye Hospital, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand and LNJP Eye Hospital, Chauparan, Bihar on 19 and 20 September at the suggestion of Mission for Vision.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- We have started rehabilitation of third group of 24 blinds from last month. Alongside, follow up of curable blinds identified during the survey is also going on. We have continued conducting weekly diagnostic eye camps in the project area. 9 Camps were organised during the month. 699 patients were examined and 67 surgeries have been carried out.

Diagnostic eye camps:

- We had continued door to door screening and adhoc eye camp activity in Dediapada taluka. During the month, we have screened 15438 individuals and distributed 584 readymade spectacles and 120 tailor-made spectacles. Good number of surgical patients has continued to come from Dediapada inspite of rains.

LASIK pressnote

GENERAL

- We have started doing LASIK procedure (Removal of spectacles) from this month. We are very thankful to Dr. Nirav Shah for taking this initiative and supporting us in every step. Our sincere thanks to Dr. Darshan Kalaigar also for standing by our side like a rock in getting started.
- We have shifted to the new campus during the last weekend of June. Towards the end of the month, students have also been shifted. Now, shifting is completed. However, some work is still going on in the campus.
- Ganesh puja was done at old hospital building as we have vacated the building.
- Umarpada comprehensive screening project implementation started from September 2024. Door to door screening was completed in July. Follow up activity has already been started for all those who were referred but have not yet availed services.. We have screened 83044 Individuals in total which includes 427 new screening done during this month. 8 Camps were organised and 321 Individuals were examined and 40 cataract surgeries and 5 other surgeries have been performed including patients referred from vision centres and walk in patients coming to the base hospital.
- Lions club of Surat Athwalines team visited us during the month and sponsored 26 operations.
- NIIF IFL has released funds after signing of the MOU. Order for both equipments - phaco machine and full function retina surgery microscope has been released.
- One more Global grant with the help of Rotary Club of Surat Roundtown has been approved. We will get one more set of equipments for operation theatre.
- Ms. Ranjitha from Remidio came down to Mandvi for training our team in using Remidio fundus camera and do the reporting. Her presence increased the efficiency of our team in doing the activity. Remidio has given us two cameras for one study. Our sincere thanks to team Remidio for this support.
- Eye donation awareness rally was carried out in Umarzar village on 8th Sept. as a part of eye donation fortnight celebration.
- Two of our esteemed donors - Shri Vimleshbhai Shah from Mumbai who has been supporting our hostel for blind children for more than 10 years and Shri Nileshbhai Patel from Universal Medicaps, Vadodara who has been supporting us for gamma radiation visited us during the month. These visits encourage us to do more and better. Our sincere heartfelt thanks to both these individuals.
- Navratri celebration was done with lot of enthusiasm. Staff and students enjoyed garba. Daily prizes were distributed.
- Our trustee Shri Ramnarayan Chandakji distributed school bags and uniform to all the kids of staff.
- At the suggestion of Rotary Club of Surat, Roundtown, we conducted school screening in one school in Surat. They were very happy with the way the work was done.
