



# TEJAS EYE HOSPITAL DIVYAJYOTI TRUST



## Hospital

- We have performed 965 surgeries during this month which is about the same as what we did in June last year - 968.
- Dr. Rutul Patel has joined us as a full time Glaucoma consultant from 23<sup>rd</sup> June.
- Dr. Nidhi Meena and Dr. Bhavin Akbari joined us as Comprehensive Fellow from 1<sup>st</sup> June.
- A live thread worm was removed from sub conjunctival space of an old lady. This is the fourth time we have removed live worm from the eye in 14 years. Dr. Uma Shroff, Dr. Dhara Sardhara and Dr. Mansi Shah managed this patient very well.
- A Congenital Glaucoma surgery was performed during the month by Dr. Khushboo Shah during this month. The baby is doing well - irritation gone and the baby is able to keep the eye open. This was the first congenital glaucoma surgery at Divyajyoti trust.
- A Minimally Invasive Glaucoma Surgery (MIGS) was performed on an elderly patient who has undergone Liver transplant surgery and was using four anti glaucoma medications. Dr. Khushboo Shah performed this surgery and now, patient is not required to use any anti glaucoma drug.

- We had shifted door to door screening and adhoc eye camp activity in Dediapada taluka. During the month, we have screened 13762 individuals and distributed 1154 readymade spectacles and 131 tailor-made spectacles.

- We have screened 100 babies and treated 3 babies during the month.

## NETRAJYOTI TRAINING CENTRE

- Training of optometry students is going on well.
- Theory classes for vision assistant students have again been going on regularly. This batch is exceptionally good. Now, July will be their last month here.
- Dr. Uma and Dr. Himarshi had gone to Prizma Eye Hospital, Surat for five days for training in LASIK procedures during the month.
- Mrs. Anilaben retired head nurse from Jayaben Modi Hospital took theory exam of our nursing staff during the month. Practical exam will be planned now.

## Research Project

- Eyecreel 600 IOL study of Biotech is completed. 425 patients were enrolled and 377 patients have undergone both eye surgeries. With less than 20% drop out rate, we could complete the enrolment. Follow up will continue for 3 years.
- Site Initiation Visit for Eycryl Toric IOL from Biotech was carried out on 13<sup>th</sup> June. They have already sent us the lenses and injectors. We will start the study soon next month.
- 09 myopia patients enrolled in the Spectacle film trial during last month have received their spectacles. 2 new enrolments have been done and order for their spectacles is sent to LVPEI.

## VIVEKANAND PRAGNACHAKSHU BHAVAN:

- Schools have reopened during the month. There are five students in the hostel right now. Four more students have been invited to come. Hopefully, their parents will bring them over soon.



## TRUCK DRIVERS' EYE CHECK UP:

## CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

## GENERAL

GUJARAT Chemical Port Limited team came forward with a request to screen 4000 truck drivers this year. We have started this activity from April and screened 720 Truck drivers during the month. 321 Individuals were provided with readymade spectacles and 17 Individuals were provided tailor-made glasses. 5 individuals are referred to base hospital for further examination.

We have completed rehabilitation of second group of 24 blinds by the end of this month. Alongside, follow up of curable blinds identified during the survey is also going on. Third group of 24 blind clients will be taken up from next month. We have continued conducting weekly diagnostic eye camps in the project area. 9 Camps were organised during the month. 629 patients were examined and 71 surgeries have been carried out.

We have shifted to the new campus during the last weekend of the month. We could not shift operation theatres because some activities are still pending in the OT. Similarly, some work in the training centre is also ongoing. Hopefully, we will be able to shift completely by the end of next month. The staff members and our students poured their heart out in shifting process. They manage it so well that there is not a single equipment being damaged nor anybody got even the slightest injury. This is an amazing feat that they have achieved. Our heartfelt congratulations to each and every staff member and students involved in the shifting process.

Umarpada comprehensive screening project implementation started from September 2024. 6730 individuals were examined during the month. Alongside door to door screening, weekly diagnostic eye camps and awareness sessions at night have been started. 8 Camps were organised and 718 Individuals were examined and 97 cataract surgeries and 6 other surgeries have been performed including patients referred from vision centres and walk in patients coming to the base hospital. 5 awareness sessions have been conducted and 88 persons attended the same.

### FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT - TEJAS EYE HOSPITAL, MANDVI

"I opened two gifts this morning. They were my eyes". The eyes are the most precious gift given to us by nature and life would be very difficult without them, as 80% of what we perceive around us comes through our sense of sight.

Rotary Club of Surat Roundtown has always undertaken projects related to enlighten over its 33 years of service, the most outstanding being its association with the Divyajyoti Trust. For 10 years, the club has been in contact with the Trust serving 'divya' community in and around Mandvi, and this started a long association between two service oriented entities. In 2012-13 the first Global Grant project was done, followed by four more GIs, where in equipments for base hospital / satellite centers were given and test OT's made. All the equipments are well utilized and duly reported in the annual report of the trust.

Divyajyoti Trust was established in 2010 by two committed social workers, Bhalendra Bhushan Shah and ophthalmologist Dr. Divya Gajiwale, with an aim to serve the tribal population. Dr. Gajiwale, who had previously worked for 20 years at Tata Road, Jagdis, says "Mandvi is a small underdeveloped town near Surat with a population of approx. 40,000 and not well connected. There was no eye care provider in the area and thus Tejas Eye Hospital was established here".

### FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT - TEJAS EYE HOSPITAL, MANDVI

Dr. Divya Gajiwale says "Tejas Eye Hospital has been a great support to Divyajyoti Trust since the beginning. Since 2012 five GIs have been carried out which have provided the hospital with major equipments, up gradation and making of OT's. Annual performance in 2024 was - 75000 OPD visits, 16000 surgeries, Cataract work - 85% free, 10% students trained on the campus".

**Achievements:**

From 2011 till date 11,00,000+ OPD patients were seen, 1,40,000+ eye surgeries performed, 1800+ cataract transplants conducted, 180+ ophthalmologists trained, 200+ paramedics trained and 450+ blind individuals were rehabilitated. Annual 80% operations are done free of cost and heavily subsidized for others. Trust also runs vision training programs for para-medical workers - one year certificate course for vision technicians and four year bachelor degree course in Optometry. Over and above, Community Based Rehabilitation of blind people is also done which is rarely done by other hospitals and there is a hostel for blind children also.
